

This is a re-registration for two existing human crematories.

EU 003 is an IEE (Matthews Cremation) Ener-Tek crematory that was installed in 1992.

EU 004 is an IEE (Matthews Cremation) Super Power Pak crematory that was installed in 2003.

Each incinerator consists of primary and secondary (afterburner) chambers, each fired on LPG.

Emissions from both units are controlled by afterburners that maintain minimum secondary chamber combustion zone temperatures of 1600°F prior to and during combustion of material in the primary chambers. The secondary chambers are designed to ensure one second residence time at a gas temperature of 1800°F, and are equipped with continuous temperature monitors and recorders. The units are equipped with opacity monitors that adjust the cremation process if excess opacity is measured.
