

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.





The manufacturing facility will utilize three 85 ton cement storage silos. The existing two silos employ C & W Model CP-310 silo mounted dust collectors. The new silo will use a Stanley Batch Systems Model 252R dust collector to control particulate from the pneumatic unloading of cement. (Presently two silos are operational, the third will be installed.) The weigh hopper and batcher are located inside the plant. Only the storage silos are vented outdoors.
