

The surface coating of trash cans will use the identical products and methods as autobody refinishing. This facility is installing two Garmat Tier I paint spray booths with integrated drying burners. The paint spray booth is a pressurized semi-downdraft booth with glass fiber filtration media (99.5% efficiency) for particulate control. The booth burners each contain a 997,000 Btu natural gas fired burner. *SEC./min/hr.?*

The emissions from the equipment will consist of VOC's and a small amount of particulate after filtration. Criteria pollutants from the combustion of natural gas are also emitted. The applicator is a high efficiency gravity feed gun that provides equal or better efficiency of transfer than HVLP. A Hercules GW/R-T totally enclosed gun washer will also be used for cleanup.
