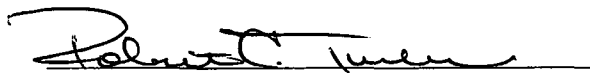

Ready Mix Concrete is the only product produced.

Portland Cement and Fly Ash---Inventory computer controlled and reconciled daily.

The bag house on top of the silos allow air to escape through the filters while capturing all cementitious particulates.

The bag houses are required to be inspected at least once a month.

A complete set of bags and cartridges are kept in stock at the facility for the bag house and filter vents, in the event of replacement is needed immediately to prevent emissions.

An overfill alarm is present, functional and inspected. The alarm will sound in the event of overloading of a silo from a cement bulker allowing time to stop the overfill, and to prevent a cement or fly ash discharge in to the atmosphere, which would cause an environmental hazard and violation.

The plant has a dust collection system and spray bar at the point of loading, and captures any airborne particulates that fail to load directly in to the ready mix truck drum.

The aggregates are sprayed with water 24 hours a day to saturate the material and prevent any dry particulates from entering the ground or the air.

The grounds are washed weekly and street sweepers are utilized on a regular basis to clean any dry dust particulates from entering the atmosphere and leaving the plant property.

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. The plant is currently using 8 concrete mixer trucks for loading and delivery. Ready Mix production is approximately 0 to 300 cubic yards of concrete a day when the facility is in operation. Currently the facility is in operation on an intermittent amount of days during the week, and can be closed for business on any given day. If production of Ready Mix Concrete is increased and economic conditions improve, the facility may be open, Monday-Saturday, 6 days a week. Hours of operation can be between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Products being used are Portland Cement, Fly Ash and natural aggregates.

The concrete batch plant facility has been in operation since July of 1988. The plant runs on a closed loop system, and all equipment and processes are modern, current and in compliance.

Daily inspections of the facility are conducted and documented.

A 2 compartment cement silo is modern and maintained on a daily basis. The silos hold cement and fly ash, and have a capacity of 782 barrels. There are 2 C&W Model CP-305 silo dust filters mounted on top of the silo. Units are equipped with a high volume, high pressure reverse pulse jet cleaning mechanism. There are eight 8"x39" cartridges, which provide 304 square feet of polyester filter media in each. The cement batcher is enclosed by a C&W CP-35 Enclosed Dust Collection system. It comes with two 8"x19" filters with 88 pleats and 36 square feet of 100% polyester filter media. Each side of the silo pipes, have anti-overfill pinch valves. A C&W filter system is used at the point of loading. The vacuum removes and stores particulates. The material collected is returned to the silo.

If any cementitious material is discharged into the atmosphere, the Environmental Mgr. must be notified. The Environmental Mgr. will notify the DEP of the discharge, and fill out the required paper work.

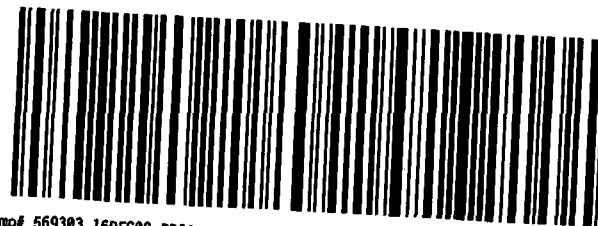

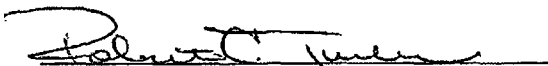

- An alarm must be functional and sound in the event of overloading of a silo from a cement bulker allowing time to stop the overfill and to prevent a cement or fly ash discharge in to the atmosphere which would cause an environmental hazard and violation.

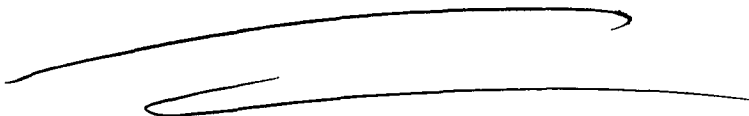

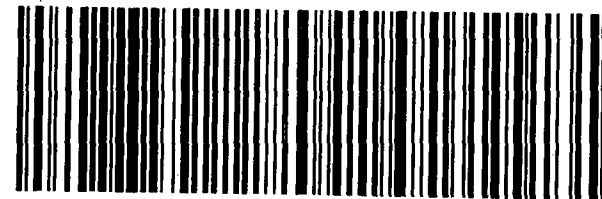
