

Dear Mr. Meyer:

Upon review of our records, the Palm Beach County Health Department, hereafter referred to as Department, believes that you may be operating without entitlement.

On May 19, 2010 a representative of the Department conducted an inspection of the above-referenced surface coating facility. Our records indicate that you have claimed eligibility for your facility to operate under a Non-Title V Air General Permit (AGP), pursuant to Chapter 62-210, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and that your entitlement to operate expired on 9/11/2009.

As a source of air pollution, your facility is entitled to operate for no more than five (5) years with an AGP under Section § 403.0872 Florida Statutes (F.S.). Rule 62-210.310, F.A.C., establishes that the duration of the AGP is for five (5) years, and no later than thirty (30) days prior to the fifth anniversary of the filing of intent to use this AGP, the owner/operator or authorized representative shall submit a new notice of intent which shall contain all current information regarding the facility.

The PBCHD believes that the following statutes, rules, and/or regulations may have been violated:

Florida Statutes: Chapter 403 - Environmental Control Part I Pollution Control

Section 403.161(1) (b) - Prohibitions, violation, penalty, intent - It shall be a violation of this chapter, and it shall be prohibited for any person:

To fail to obtain any permit required by this chapter or by rule or regulation, or to violate or fail to comply with any rule, regulation, order, permit, or certification adopted or issued by the department pursuant to its lawful authority.

Florida Administrative Code: Chapter 62-4.030 - General Prohibition

Any stationary installation which will reasonably be expected to be a source of pollution shall not be operated, maintained, constructed, expanded, or modified without the appropriate and valid permits issued by the Department, unless the source is exempted by Department rule. The Department may issue a permit only after it receives reasonable assurance that the installation will not cause pollution in violation of any of the provisions of Chapter 403, F.S., or the rules promulgated there under. A permitted installation may only be operated, maintained, constructed, expanded, or modified in a manner that is consistent with the terms of the permit.

Florida Administrative Code: Chapter 62-210.300

Unless exempted from permitting pursuant to this rule or Rule 62-4.040, F.A.C., the owner or operator of any facility or emissions unit which emits or can reasonably be expected to emit any air pollutant shall obtain appropriate authorization from the Department prior to undertaking any activity at the facility or emissions unit for which such authorization is required. The Department grants authorization to conduct such activities by individual air permit or by air general permit.


Furthermore, Sections 403.161 and 403.141, Florida Statutes (F.S.) provide that whoever commits a violation shall be liable to the state for any damage caused and civil penalties up to \$10,000 per violation per day or portion thereof.

If your company wishes to pursue an administrative resolution of this matter, please contact Thomas Tittle at the Palm Beach County Health Department, 800 Clematis Street, Fourth Floor, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401, telephone number (561) 837-5979, within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter. A meeting will be arranged with representatives of the Palm Beach County Health Department to address the issues raised herein, review corrective actions and appropriate civil penalties.

Failure to respond to this notice may result in further enforcement action.

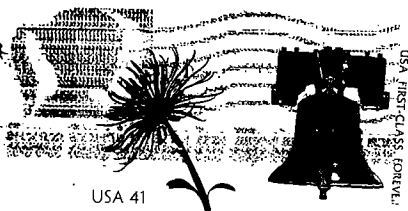
