Gentlemen,

I need some help. The subject item facility has been permitted as a **Surface Coating (SC) Operation** since July 1996 (initial) and then subsequently renewed in 2001 and then a change of ownership registration in 2004. I have just received a registration renewal for this facility on a **Reinforced Polyester Resin (RPR) Operations Air General Permit Registration Form**. It indicates on the form that this is a re-registration and states that between October 2007 – October 2008 that the facility used 5000 lbs of styrene-containing materials (resin & gel-coat). No reference to painting of course.

My questions are:

1. Is this facility an SC or an RPR Operation?
 2. Have they discontinued the SC Operation? When I look in ARMS there is no indication of a discontinuance of the SC Operation and there is no reference or comments to this facility being an RPR Operation
 3. If there is a permitted SC Operation and a RPR Operation located at this facility, should it not be permitted as a Major Source or Title V facility? As you are aware two (2) air general permitted facilities may not be co-located unless allowed by rule, and in the case of SC Ops & RPR Ops there is no allowance in the rules for co-location.
