This modification is for the addition of a second concrete batching operation to be called Plant Number 2. The single silo is split between cement and flyash. Each side holds 50 tons of product. The silo was manufectured by Coneco/Besser. There are separate baghouses controlling each side of the silo. Each bag house contains forty-two 4 inch diameter by 66 inch long bags. The baghouses are built by Coneco.

The Batching operation is controlled by a separate dust collector. The dust collector is built by Griffin. It contains two hundred and sixteen 4 inch diameter by 78 inch long bags.

B.E.T.ER Mix, Inc. will at all times take reasonable precautions to prevent its Cement Batch Plant and associated facilities from emitting unconfined particulate matter. These precautions will include:

- 1) Maintaining and operating all air pollution control equipment required by the General Permit.
- 2) Watering roads as necessary to prevent vehicular traffic from entraining dust.
- 3) Posting and enforcing a 5 miles per hour (mph) speed limit in all areas.
- 4) Performing regular maintenance of roads, yards, and parking areas to prevent accumulation of dust.
- 5) Training equipment operators to minimize drop heights during loading and unloading operations.
