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#### **Description of Facility**

This facility consists of an office, maintenance areas, parking area, various conveying equipment, aggregate piles and a decorative patio and paver stone manufacturing facility.

The manufacturing facility utilizes seven cement storage silos, each with a separate WAM silotop series RO1 dust collector with 264 sq ft of cartridge area, using 7 cartridge elements with a maximum flow of 1500 ACFM. The cloth to air ratio is 6 to 1 with an efficiency of 99.9%. The cartridges are cleaned by the pulse method. These dust collectors control particulate emissions when the product is pneumatically transferred from the tanker truck to the silo. There is also a 450 barrel bin silo that utilizes a 250 sq ft capacity, top mount bag collector that has an electric vibrator for cleaning and purges back into the silo.

The facility operates 24 hours per day, 6 days per week, 52 weeks per year.
