This facility consists of an office building, parking area, a block manufacturing plant with two silos to store the materials used in the block making process and a mixer/batcher. This application is to add the existing weigh hopper dust collector to the Air General Permit Registration.

Materials used in the manufacture of concrete block will be pneumatically transferred from tanker trucks to storage silos. Emissions from the transfer of materials and the batching operation will be controlled by a central dust collector. Emissions from the mixer/batcher are controlled by a separate dust collector.

The following emission points will be in use:

EU 001 Silo #1 (860 cu. ft.), Silo #2 (1336 cu. ft.) and the weigh hopper emissions are controlled by a Cone-E-Co Lo Pro Central Cust Collector Model 10 Serial No. C-57832L DWG#0142-26C

EU-002 - Mixer/Batcher emissions are controlled by a Cone-E-Co batcher vent Model 10 C-57832L DWG#0142-26C

* Note: The batcher and dust collectors are supplied as a single unit with one part number

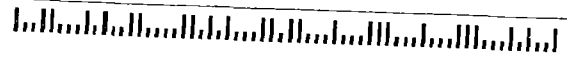


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
