FYI-The following facility (Mr. Pat Murray, the Owner/Authorized Representative) has WITHDRAWN their latest registration originally submitted for the purpose of a proposed physical relocation of their Reinforced Polyester Resin Operations (RPRO).

JMJ Fiberglass Inc has decided to and will continue to operate at their current location of 6564 44th St N #801, Pinellas Park, FL 33781 under entitlement #1030291-003-AG until such time, or when and if JMJ decides to relocate their operations to the Hutchins Co Inc dba Com-Pac Yachts location at 1195 Kapp Rd., Clearwater, FL 33765.

If, in the future, JMJ decides move to the Com-Pac Yachts facility (#1030522), JMJ will surrender their Air General (AG) permit entitlement and operate under the Hutchins Co Inc AG entitlement so long as the combination of the two entities does not force their combined use of styrene containing resin and gel-coat to exceed the RPRO Air General permit thresholds of 76,000 pounds (thirty-eight (38) tons) in any consecutive twelve (12) months (Rule 62-210.310(3)(d), F.A.C. If in-fact, the combination of the two operations would result in an exceedance of the AGP thresholds, they would not be eligible for use of the air general permit.

In the event JMJ Fiberglass Inc decides to move to the Com-Pac Yachts location, and the combined usage remains within the AGP thresholds, Com-Pac Yachts will have to renew their RPRO AGP entitlement under the change of equipment provisions of Rule 62-210.310(2)(e), F.A.C., Equipment Changes.
