Plant has 4 large exhaust fans that face west, they project over heavy industrial railway area. we also use specialized exhaust fans on the floor to dissipate fumes. General closed doors controls the amount of fumes. We run closed tip gun now which is considerably less air flow at lower air pressures which doesn't allow for overspray and controlled spraying. We are also hand rolling large areas of hulls/decks which in some cases eliminates the use of resin gun wet out equipment having to be used.

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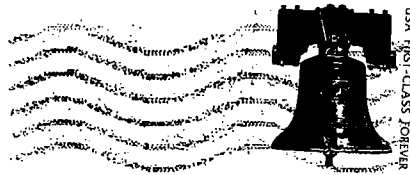
