Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

This facility is provided with an extensive stormwater/wastewater drainage system, which is designed to flush particulate matter from the paved yard and traffic areas. This keeps the paving cleaner, substantially reducing fugitive emissions. Aggregate stockpiles in the yard are stored on paved surfaces and kept watered, partly for quality control and partly to reduce potential emissions from these materials. Unused concrete which is brought back to the site is stored in a concrete-walled washout structure, which reduces the area needed to dry the material, while keeping it out of the main traffic pattern, where it would generate additional fugitive emissions.

Description of Facility
