Dear Mr. Maine:

A review of our files has disclosed that your permit will expire on March 26, 2009.

Operation of a pollution source without a valid permit from the Department of Environmental Regulations is a violation of Chapter 62-4.03, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and Section 403.161, Florida Statutes.

Rule 62-210.310(2)(c)2, F.A.C. states that to avoid lapse of authority to operate, an owner or operator intending to use, or continue to use, an air general permit must submit the proper registration form and processing fee **at least 30 days prior to expiration** of the facility's existing air operation permit or air general permit. Renewal information for your type of facility can be found at http://www.dep.state.fl.us/Air/permitting/nontv_gp.htm.

Failure to submit an application in a timely manner could result in a violation of Department rules. A renewal application that is not submitted in a timely matter, as noted above, may require the operator to shut down any emission sources at expiration and will not be allowed to operate until a renewal permit is issued.
