Emissions from the silo loading operation are controlled by a Conoco Model 30-250 dust collector mounted on top of each of the two cement storage silos. Emissions from the drop point of the truck loadout and weigh hopper are controlled by a Conoco PJ980 Central Dust Collector.

Plant #2

Emissions from the loading of the two cement storage silos and the truck loadout are controlled by a Conoco model PJ1400. The weigh hopper emissions are controlled by a Conoco Model BV-14-23 filter vent.
