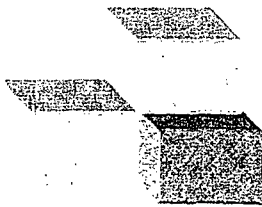

The facility also operates a solvent recycler to recover acetone used in the cleaning of equipment.

Facility production has been reduced significantly over the past few years that it now meets the requirements of the air general permit.

As of today, September 24, 2009, the subject item facility has migrated to the Reinforced Polyester Resin Operations AGP as an initial entitlement under the air general permit registration program.

As required by Rule 62-210.310(2)(b)1., F.A.C., - Air General Permits – General Procedures:

1. Initial Registration. Registration of a facility which is not currently authorized to construct or operate under the terms and conditions of an air general permit is classified as an initial registration. Any existing, individual air operation permit(s) authorizing operation of the facility must be surrendered by the owner or operator, effective upon the first day of use of the air general permit.
