The plant has two cement silos, 800 ton capacity each. The air pollution control equipment includes dust collection system (Model PJ-1400) and cement batcher vent (Model 14-235). The dust collection system has 96 bags, 6" diameter at 120" Length made of polyester felt. The minimum design efficiency of dust collector is 99.9%. The cement batcher vent has 14 bags made of polyester with the bag efficiency at 99.9%. It has a capacity of 180 CFM maximum.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The existing concrete batching plant is located on Briarglen Road next to the existing WPR Plant. The plant has four storage bins, batching equipment (including two 800 ton cement silos, four 200 ton aggregate bins, and the transfer conveyor).

The batching process uses reuse water for batching concrete. The plant also has Type I washing pad and Type II washing facilities with sediment pits, reuse water reservoir and reuse water pumps.

The plant is designed to batch 500 cubic yards of concrete daily, using 2/3 of gravel and 1/3 of sand. Additionally, it will use 450 pounds of cement per cubic yard of concrete. The plant operates 10 to 12 hours daily.

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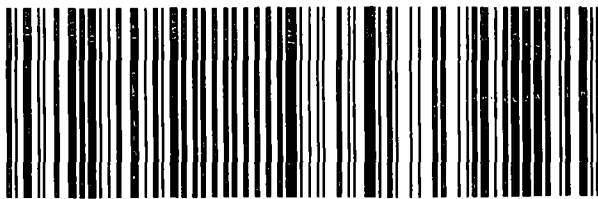
