This facility will be provided with an extensive stormwater/wastewater drainage system, designed to flush particulate matter from the paved yard and entrance drive. This will keep the paving cleaner, substantially reducing fugitive emissions. Aggregate stockpiles in the yard will be stored on paved surfaces and kept watered, partly for quality control and partly to reduce potential emissions from these materials. Unused concrete that is brought back to the site will be stored in a concrete-walled washout structure, reducing the area needed to dry the material, while keeping it out of the main traffic pattern, where it would generate additional fugitive emissions.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. A proposed Ready-Mix Concrete Batching Facility, which will utilize cement, flyash, slag and aggregate materials to produce ready-mix concrete. Dust emissions generated during the filling of the plant's silos or loading of concrete mixer trucks will be controlled by cartridge dust collectors. Details of these proposed emissions units (EU's) are as follows:

EU-01 - Cement silo compartment no. 1 (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-LPR-8-S cartridge dust collector).

EU-02 - Cement silo compartment no. 2 (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-LPR-8-S cartridge dust collector).

EU-03 - Flyash/slag silo compartment no. 1 (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-LPR-8-S cartridge dust collector).

EU-04 - Flyash/slag silo compartment no. 2 (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-LPR-8-S cartridge dust collector).

EU-05 - Cement weigh hopper (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-100-127 cartridge batcher vent).

EU-06 - Concrete mixer truck loadout (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-1220-1678 central cartridge dust collector).

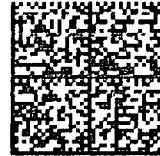
