Dear Ms. Tavares,

Thank you for your inquiry regarding the procedures to INACTIVATE your Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaner Air General Permit registration, since you are no longer using PERC as your dry cleaning solvent.

In order to change your PERC facility status to INACTIVE, we would need a letter from you requesting inactivation and a statement to the effect that :

- 1) All PERC has been removed from the PERC machine.
- 2) All PERC, used and unused, has been removed from the site, when & by whom.
- 3) Your PERC machine has been electrically and mechanically disconnected and removed from the site, and when that occurred.
