Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

Aggregates for making concrete block are stored in walled bins, with aggregates being kept below wall height.

A belt conveyor, which has a spray bar attached to control dust, carries materials to overhead bins. Materials stored in these bins are introduced into a weigh hopper that is enclosed and protected from the wind.

Once weighed the materials are carried by conveyor to the mixer which is located inside the facility, protected from the wind.

The mixer has a Mertz³⁵ dust collector attached which collects dust from the mixing operation. Cement is stored outside the plant in a weatherproof silo. This silo²⁵⁰ has a Mertz baghouse attached which controls dust during the filling process.

Before materials exit the mixer water is added which bonds the materials together and keeps it from dusting.

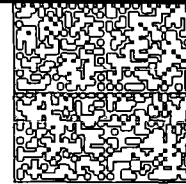
The dust collector attached to the mixer at the Defuniak and Pensacola location are a Mertz 35.

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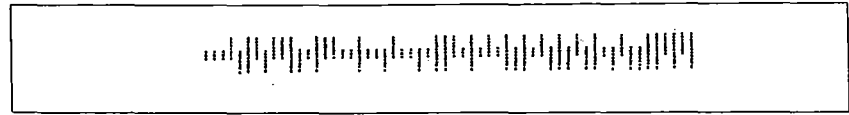

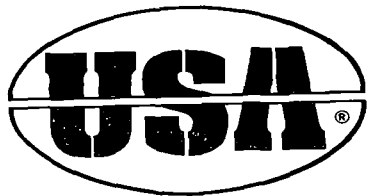
