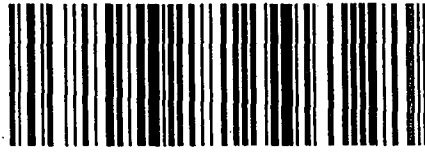

Emissions from the batching/truck loading operation are controlled by a shroud and a C&W CP900 central dust collection system.

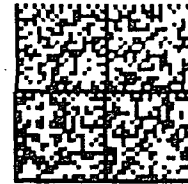

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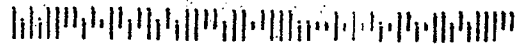
