CONCRETE RECYCLING OPERATION

Operation is a temporary broken concrete recycling operation that reduces waste concrete to materials that can be reused in the construction of roadways and for sewer and water pipe bedding. This process is utilized in lieu of landfilling the broken concrete and to produce a recycled product with a retail value that has many uses. The equipment used for processing is an Impact Crusher, Portable Screen, ~~Hydraulic Excavator, Wheel Loader and over the road dump trucks~~ all diesel powered. The crusher has a water pump with spray bars strategically located at various areas on the crusher to control air pollution while in use. This site utilizes a water truck to control air pollution generated by the traveling of the wheel loader and dump trucks. Parking areas and roads are maintained in good condition. Dump trucks operate at reduced travel speeds while on site to reduce dust emissions.

Secondly, it was entered as a STATIONARY source and should have been entered as a RELOCATABLE 777.

This is just to confirm. Usually crushers are rated in **T/hr** and your information is labeled T/day. The rule for crushers request machine rated capacity in T/hr since crushers in excess of a certain machine rated T/hr threshold are subject to Code of Federal Regulations. Please provide in T/hr.

Also, please provide the number of conveyors, or drop points on the machine since those are subject to a fugitive dust opacity requirement.
