

The crusher engine and auxiliary generator are not subject to 40 CFR 60, Subpart OOO and are not required to conduct annual visible emissions compliance tests.

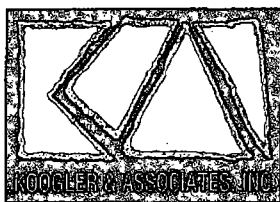
