Dear Mr. Devane:

This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on September 10, 2007. We have assigned ARMS # 7774823-004 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



Required Corrections

Dick,

This email is to confirm our discussion of Friday (10/19/2007) pertaining to the needed corrections for this project.

This project has eight (8) Emission Units which includes three (3) "Crushers". I understand that the original ID: number of 0150073 was changed to a relocatable 7774832 number. Apparently because the permittee had sent you a "relocatable" notice for the crushers, you had Yi Zhu change the ID Number to the 7774832 relocatable

series.

In actuality, only the crushers are to be classified as relocatable, and the remainder of the facility should remain as a "fixed" facility.

It is also important to know, that in all applications, each relocatable crusher should have it's own 777.....(relocatable) General Permit regardless if it is governed by 40 CFR 60, Subpart OOO or not..... **(Never combine two (2) or more crushers on the same "relocatable" permit. Each is to have a separate permit).**

REQUIRED ACTION for CORRECTION

1. Have Yi Zhu re-establish the original ID number 0150073 for the facility.
2. Change Crushers (EU-003, EU-004 and EU-005) to "inactive" status. (I) on this facility.
3. Assign the 7774832 "Relocatable" number to "Primary Crusher 1 (EU-003) only.
4. Have your permittee send two (2) more General Permit applications with the \$100.00 fee for each of the remaining crushers, to be applied to the Universal, Primary Crusher 2 (EU-004) and the Pegson, Primary Crusher 3 (EU-005).

The final results should be: Facility (with EU-007 thru EU-011) to remain as the fixed facility ID No.: 0150073

EU-003 (Pioneer Crusher- Primary Crusher 1).....	"	7774832
EU-004 (Universal Crusher -Primary Crusher 2)	"	777.....(to be assigned) (requires new application and fee)
EU-005 (Pegson Crusher - Primary Crusher 3)	"	777

Note:

- a) You may want to inquire if the EU-011 crusher is to be classed as a "relocatable" also. If indeed it is, then it would require the same treatment.
- b) I highly recommend that you contact Bill Arlington and work this with, or thru him. (I would always go thru the PE involved on all projects, as first protocol to keep communications in order.
- c) You mentioned that Arlington said he was told that all "Subpart OOO" crushers were to be handled by the Districts. Please explain to him that this is NOT true, and that they are to go through you and Tallahassee as all General Permits do.

I hope this will serve to confirm our telephone conversation and clarify the actions that need to be taken.
