2) Watering roads as necessary to prevent vehicular traffic from entraining dust.			
3) Posting and enforcing a 5 miles per hour (mph) speed limit in all areas.			
4) Performing regular maintenance of roads, yards and parking areas to prevent accumulation of dust.			
5) Training equipment operators to minimize drop heights during loading and unloading operations.			
6) Configuring conveyors and stackers so that transfer point drop heights are minimized.			
7) Routing exiting traffic through a tire wash pit to remove dust from vehicle tires before they enter paved roadways.

This facility, known as Rock Crusher No. 2, bears Woodruff & Sons Equipment ID No. 1418 and is covered under General Permit 7775052-003-AG. The main unit bears Seral Number 33D420010856. It consists of an Eagle Model 1400 Crusher and its associated conveyor belts and stackers. The unit is relocatable and reconfigurable. Rock and waste concrete to be crushed are placed into the crusher by backhoe or front end loader. The oversize material is returned to the entrance by conveyor and the properly sized material is either sent to a screener or to storage. The unit is sometimes located in a yard that also has a permitted soil cement plant present.
