The crusher is located at a limestone quarry and processes only material from onsite natural deposits. Per Rule 62-210.310(5)(e)3.c.(I) FAC, no water suppression system with spray bars is required. The mined material is wet, which assists with preventing unconfined particulate matter emissions.

Unconfined emissions generated by vehicular traffic or wind is controlled by applying water from water trucks equipped with spray bars on a regular basis to all stockpiles, roadways, and work yards where the nonmetallic mineral processing plant is located.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the nonmetallic mineral processing operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. The Bohringer Champ crusher processes limestone at Limerock Industries' Newberry Quarry. Associated equipment consists of a screening operation, a 525 horsepower Caterpillar diesel engine, an under feeder fines belt, under crusher belt and stacker belt. The Bohringer crusher processes approximately 700 tons of limestone per hour. The crushed limestone is used for road base and other construction applications.

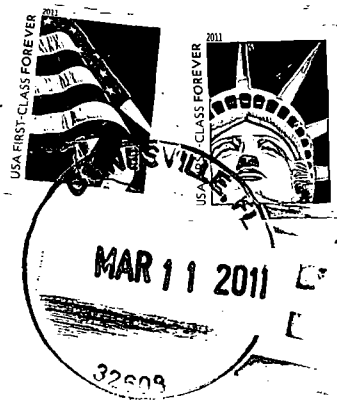
