Raw material is sprayed down with water. Sprinklers are set up in roadways. Spray bars are attached to the entrance of the crusher. Finished product is stockpiled and also sprayed down with water.

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Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the nonmetallic mineral processing operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Waste rubble concrete and/or asphalt is loaded into horizontal impact crusher with excavator. Material goes through crusher and onto conveyor. Crushed material goes up to screen, where material is either screened out to the finished product conveyor, or recirculated back into the crusher. This recirculated material goes through the crushing screening process until it is the desired size. Once the material is sized correctly, the finished product travels on a conveyor and drops into a pile. Finished product is then picked up by a loader and put into the stockpile.
