
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on October 11, 2007. We have assigned ARMS # 7775440-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



Description of Reasonable Precautions

The company operates a small crushed limestone facility in Marion County. The combined fuel consumption for all equipment on the property is less than 100,000 gallons annually.

The nonmetallic processing plant located at our quarry processes only material from onsite deposits and is therefore excluded from the need for a water suppression system. The single day capacity for the processing plant is 2,000 tons.

We have limited the dust emissions caused by vehicular traffic by paving the access road to the quarry and to the scale.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the nonmetallic mineral processing operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The company excavates limestones from onsite deposits with the use of track-hoe type excavators. Material is gathered from both above surface and below water level deposits. The raw material is then fed into a crusher that breaks the limestone down to a size of less than 2.5 inches. A radial conveyor stacks the finished product. The material is loaded onto trucks with a front-end loader with a capacity of approximately 7 yards.
