Dear Mr. Schindler:

This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on November 13, 2007. We have assigned ARMS # 7775447-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.





This is an application for registration for a Metso Model LT1110, Serial No. 73668 Non Metallic Mineral Crushing Machine. It has a design capacity of 300 TPH, and utilizes three 39" spray bars located at the crusher entrance, exit and at the main conveyor. There is one screen at the feeder grizzly. The machine is powered by a Caterpillar C-10, 335 horsepower engine. The conveyors are manufacturered by Metso, the main conveyor is a model H10-10, the side conveyor is a H5-5. This unit is owned by Peninsula Equipment, Inc. and is intended to be used as lease equipment. Peninsula Equipment, Inc. will not be operating or overseeing the operation of this machine.
