Dear Ms. Vince:

This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility which was received on December 24, 2007. We have assigned ARMS No. 7775484-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



Description of Reasonable Precautions

Stockpiles are watered to prevent wind erosion. Stockpiles of sand and aggregate are located within concrete bunkers which serves to reduce the stockpile height and also as wind breaks. When the trucks pull under the silo, the drop point is equipped with a dust shroud where the aggregate, sand, cement and fly ash drop into the trucks thus reducing the potential for dust. The drop point is also equipped with a spray bar to further reduce particulate emissions.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The plant is a Vince Hagan HT Series Haganator Travel-All portable plant. It consists of two "piggy-back" silos. Each silo is equipped with a WAM dust collector. The silos may contain cement or fly ash, depending on the requirements. A weigh scale is located at the batcher vent and a spray bar to control dust is located at the drop point where the cement, aggregate and water drop into the route trucks. In addition, a "pig" or horizontal temporary portable silo will also be located at the plant to provide additional storage capacity for cement. The "pig" has a capacity of approximately 180 tons and is equipped with a dust collector.

This temporary plant will be constructed for a site-specific project. It will provide concrete for the construction of a cement mill. No concrete will be sold from this plant. The plant will be constructed on the same property as the cement mill and, once the cement mill is completed, the temporary concrete plant will be dismantled and removed from the site. During its existence, the temporary plant will manufacture a maximum of 80 cubic yards of concrete per hour.

Plant operation will be dependent on demand. The average operation is anticipated to be 3 days per week, 12 to 18 hours a day. Some weeks, it could operate more and there will be times it could operate 24 hours a day. There will be some weeks it may not operate at all.
