“Unannounced Inspection - Crusher sold and no longer at facility.

I, James Burkholder (JB), called Mr. Fulks on October 12, 2010 at ~3:30 p.m. to verify if the crusher was in operation. Mr. Fulks stated that Florida Processing Machinery sold the crusher equipment and that it was no longer on site.

I went to Florida Processing Machinery on October 13, 2010 and verified that the crusher is not on site. It appears that the crusher was in fact sold and the facility should be inactivated. The phone call was disconnected; however, the facility will be contacted to request they rescind their permit.”
