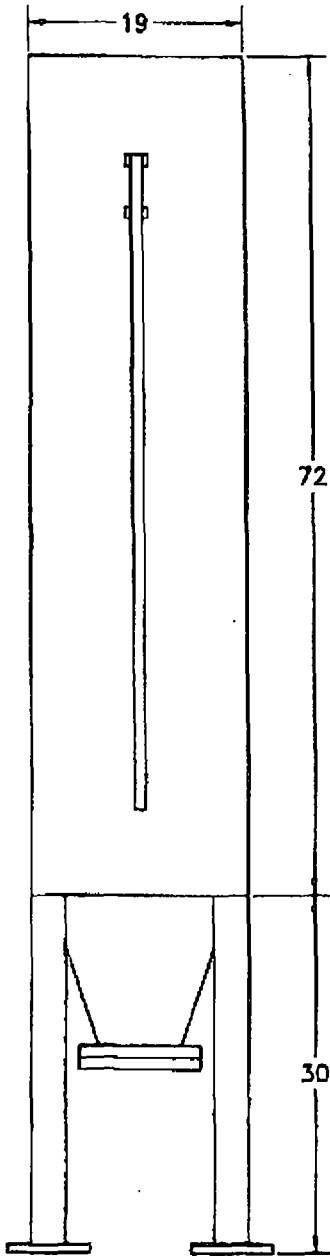

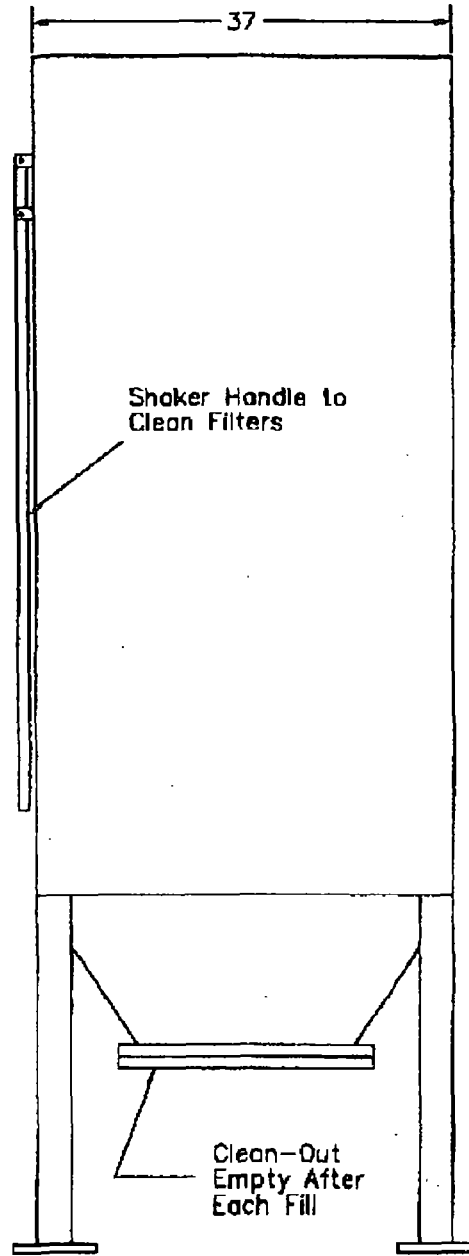

FRONT VIEW



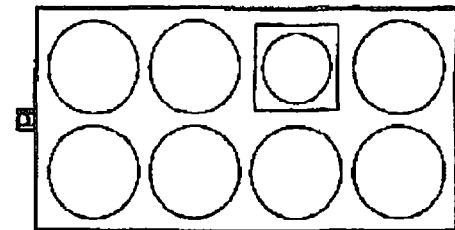


