
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on November 7, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. 7775550-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty (30) days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after five (5) years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than five (5) years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

To whom it may concern,

All raw materials processed by the MGL portable crusher located at Bergeron Sand Rock and Aggregates Star Pit Quarry contains adequate moisture so that typical operations do not create substantial amounts of dust emissions. In the event that abnormally dry conditions exist the raw material is wetted down prior to introduction into the crusher. The water is introduced to the raw material with a portable pump and spray nozzle directed at the feed location for the portable crusher.

To whom it may concern,

Material processed at Bergeron Sand, Rock & Aggregate, Inc. Star Pit Quarry is naturally occurring lime rock. Material is excavated and stockpiled wet. After excess moisture has drained from material it is then fed into our MGL portable crusher and processed into crushed Limerock Base material.

Due to the physical and geological properties of our excavated material approximately 10% moisture content is typical in the material. This level of moisture is usually sufficient in preventing the creation of air born dust during processing. In the event the material being processed is unusually dry we will introduce water into the unprocessed material prior to being fed into the MGL portable crusher. Water is introduced into the raw material via a water pump or water truck and hose with a spray nozzle.

In order to keep dust suppressed around the portable crusher area we use a water truck to spray down the surrounding area.

Dear Ms. Wooley,

Thank you for your e-mail and your inquiry regarding Bergeron's registration form for the Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plant (Crusher) Air General Permit for entitlement to operate a relocatable.

Your application and fee were received by the DEP Finance and Accounting office on November 7, 2008 and subsequently received by our office on November 12, 2008. At this point in time the thirty (30) day review window has begun.

After an initial cursory review, I have found the application to be lacking in information specific to the crusher itself and the identification of any associated peripheral equipment. For example the MGL crusher should have a model #, processing capacity of the machine in T/hr, etc. Identification of any conveyors, screening operations, equipment power sources such as internal combustion engines, emission control measures such as spray bars etc. would be helpful in identifying any additional potential sources of particulate emissions.

If, during a more in-depth review, there are further questions or concerns that may arise, or there is a need for other additional information I will contact you or Mr. Bergeron for clarification.

Thank you for your assistance in gathering the information outlined above. You may e-mail the results to me and I will attach that document as an addendum to the application
