The mined material is wet, which helps prevent unconfined particulate matter emissions. Unconfined emissions generated by vehicular traffic or wind is controlled by applying water (by water trucks equipped with spray bars) on a regular basis to all stockpiles, roadways and work yards where the nonmetallic mineral processing plant is located.


