- EU-03 Single-compartment flyash silo (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-305-839 cartridge dust collector).
- EU-04 Cement weigh hopper (with a C. & W. Dust Systems Model CP-70-419 cartridge batcher vent).
- EU-05 Truck Load-out (with a C. & W. Model CP-1220 Dust Collector)


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
