

The Crom Corporation (Crom) will take all reasonable precautions to control unconfined emissions from its concrete batch plant. All unpaved roads will have water applied as necessary to control emissions.

In addition, Crom's batch plant hopper will be fully contained and enclosed. The hopper is large enough so that it will require minimal refilling with cement over the duration of this project (2-3 times).

Finally, Crom uses a wet shotcrete application process which independent tests have confirmed does not present an air pollution hazard. A copy of the testing protocol and results is attached for review.

Description of Facility

Below, or as an attachment to this form, provide a description of the concrete batching plant operations at the facility in sufficient detail to demonstrate the facility's eligibility for use of this air general permit and to provide a basis for tracking any future equipment or process changes at the facility. Describe all air pollutant-emitting processes and equipment at the facility, and identify any air pollution control measures or equipment used.

The Crom Corporation (Crom) uses a small (9 cu/yd) capacity batch plant on an occasional basis to produce shotcrete for Crom's tank build operation. Crom uses a "wet" process to virtually eliminate emissions during the application of shotcrete. Shotcrete is transferred from the batch plant to a concrete pump. From the concrete pump, the shotcrete travels through a 4"-5" hose. Air is injected into the shotcrete at the end of the hose where an employee controls the application of the shotcrete in successive layers to complete the tank wall.

Upon completion of the tanks (24 weeks) the batch plant will be returned to Crom's Shop located at 6801 SW Archer Road, Gainesville, Florida, for cleaning and storage until the next time it is needed.

As I began the registration review process I noted that it did not contain specific equipment detail (**Page 10 – Description of Facility**) regarding the CCB Plant facility. For example we need to know the manufacturer, model number, serial number (if available), silo data &/or hopper data such as capacity in Bbls, cu.yd. or Tons, power source (Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engine (RICE) and identifiers such as diesel/gas, HP, S/N), electric, etc?).

If you would be so kind to provide this additional information it will be very helpful in the evaluation and review process.

Dear Mr. Robert Oyenarte,

It was a pleasure talking with you today regarding your Concrete Batching (CCB) Plant Air General Permit (AGP) Registration form which you submitted and we received on July 13, 2009.

First, I am happy that we were able to clarify that the four (4) forms submitted were actually duplicates of the same facility and not representative of four (4) separate and distinct facilities submitted for entitlement. With respect to the AGP program and future submissions of the AGP registration form, only one, original, signed and dated form is necessary.

Secondly, I was a bit confused that a check (#54830) for two hundred fifty dollars and no cents (\$250.00) was included since it did not meet the criteria for one (1) registration form nor four (4) registration forms. A registration and processing fee of only **one hundred dollars (\$100.00)** payable to the **FDEP** should be included along with each form/facility to be permitted.

As the result and per your instructions, I have voided your check (#54830) in the amount of \$250.00 and will be returning it to you so that you can re-issue another check for the correct amount of \$100.00. I have included a copy of the voided check and your registration form (see .pdf file attached).

However, in this instance, since we have already received your form and are awaiting the correct processing fee of \$100.00 please send the check to the following address. If we were to send it directly to our Finance & Accounting Division without a form they wouldn't know what to do with it.

A further point of clarification: Thirdly, and after our telephone conversation, I noticed that on page numbered seven (7) (actually the first page of the registration form-also see the attached .pdf file) you have listed the **Peace River/Manasota Regional Water Supply Authority** as the Facility Owner/Company Name of the CCB plant. If that entity is actually the owner of the CCB Plant then all is okay. However, if this CCB Plant facility in reality is actually owned and operated by The Crom Corporation then that is the name that should appear in the appropriate **GENERAL FACILITY INFORMATION** block of the form. The site name would be correct if that is where the CCB plant is located. Please make that correction to the form if this is the case and return with the check or e-mail a corrected, scanned copy of the page which I will append to your original registration form.

Last but not least, since this is a relocatable facility and will be entitled as such you will be able to move the unit from site to site without re-entitling. When relocating your CCB Plant you must provide notification to the FDEP District Office or Local Program office located in the geographic area in which it will be located

Air General Permit registrations need to be renewed every five (5) years. They are **not** transferrable with ownership changes, but must be renewed by the new owner.

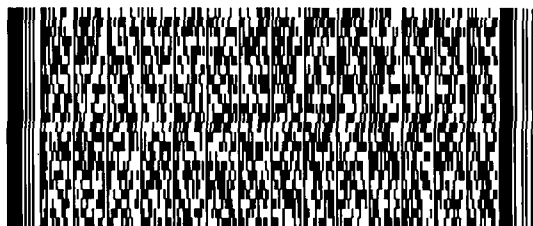

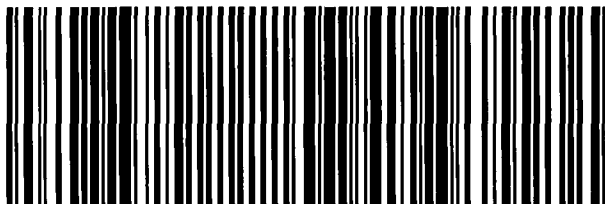
