

Description of Facility

This application is for the facility startup of a McCloskey International 36X80 Stacking Conveyor Serial Number 70358. It is powered by a 48 hp Tier III Caterpillar Diesel Engine. The conveyor is 36" by 80' and has a belt speed of 600 fpm. It has stockpiling capability that exceeds 32' high and a radial stockpile volume of 10,900 square meters.
