

The crusher is powered by a cat c-9 teir III engine with 225 horsepower and 2200 rpm. The design capacity is 100 TPH. The machine has one belt that is 30 feet long 13 feet high and 26 inches wide. There are three spray bars at the in feed of the crusher and two spray bars at the discharge of the crusher. Each bar is 36 inches long.

The purpose for my calling and consequently this e-mail is that I am in need of some additional information pertaining to the subject item forms which you have submitted for entitlement to operate your crusher equipment.

 1. What size are they (36", 48", etc.)?
 2. Where are they located on the equipment?

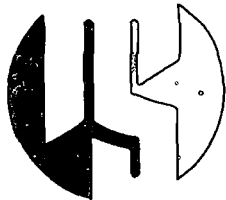

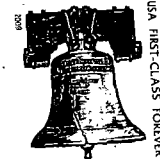
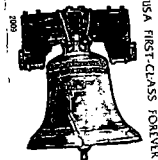
