
This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on August 26, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No: 0050072-003 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty (30) days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after five (5) years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than five (5) years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



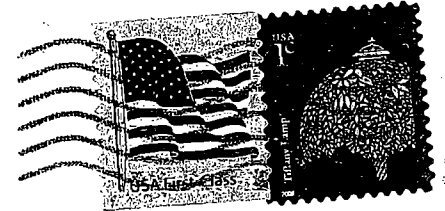

Queen Craft Shipyard manufactures and maintains its own fleet of 13 passenger and cargo vessels called crewboats. These vessels are returned to the shipyard biennially for maintenance. During this maintenance, the boats are painted as needed. The preparation process includes sandblasting as needed. A series of containment trenches are used to collect the sand and pigments from this process and prevent the materials from reaching waterways.

A new building is now being used for the sandblasting and painting operations. The building is equipped with an exhaust filtration system to remove the sandblasting and painting particles from the air. The facility also operates a solvent reclaiming still to reduce overall emissions and waste. The total annual solvent VOC emissions from the painting process for the facility are estimated to be approximately 2.3 tons per year.
