This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on July 17, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. <u>0090013-005</u> to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

Emission Unit 02 – Concrete Block Production Facility

A concrete block plant producing 1375 blocks/hr [+/- 12.8 tons/hour] of concrete - 16 hour/day; 6 days a week; 52 weeks/year -with emissions from a cement storage bin controlled by a baghouse mounted on the top of the cement silo.

EU 01 Vince Hagan Model VH-1203JP WEIGH HOPPER & TRUCK LOAD OUT WEB.

Model VH-1203JP is a "jet pulsed" free standing baghouse dust collector. Collector has 110 -6"x84" bags with a 1203 ft2 of cloth area with an air to cloth ratio of 6:1. Unit operates automatically and manually. Bags are cleaned via pulse jet with timer.

ADDED NEW SILO - CEMENT D.E.D. EU 07 C&W Model CP-305

Top of silo baghouse controlling a storage silo. The collector has 8 -8" x 39" cartridges with 356 total filtration areawith an air to cloth ratio ACFM/sq. ft.) of 4.5. Bags are cleaned via pulse jet with timer.

EU03 é EU04 SPLIT 5160 C&W Model LPR-8-S EXISTING - CEMENT/FLYASH

Two top of silo mounted baghouses. One controlling each compartment of a split storage silo. Each collector has 8 -8" x 39" cartridges with 356 total filtration area with an air to cloth ratio(ACFM/Ft²) of 6. Bags are cleaned via pulse jet with timer.

05 D.O.10. BLOCK PLANT CEMENT SICO EU 02

Griffin Environmental Model 36-J

Model 36-J on top of cement storage silo. The collector has 36 - 4" x 42" bags with 125 ft² of cloth area for an air to cloth ratio of 9:1. The baghouse operates only when the silos are being filled. A shaker mechanism is utilized for purpose of cleaning the bags.


