"Reinforced Polyester Resin Operations" - An operation that entails saturating a reinforcing material such as glass fiber with a polyester resin material. Such operations include the production or rework of product by mixing, pouring, hand laying-up, impregnating, injecting, forming, spraying, and/or curing unsaturated polyester materials with fiberglass, fillers, or any other reinforcement materials and associated cleanup.

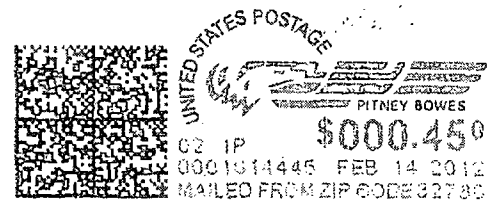
ADDENDUM "A"

Hell's Bay Marine, Inc. produces a line of small fishing boats at our facility in Titusville, Florida.

The manufacturing process is keyed on low volume custom designed low draft boats. The process utilizes a gel coat hull formed in a mold with the application of the gel coat performed in a spray booth. Following the formation of the gel coat hull hand laid and vacuum bagged layers of fiberglass using vinyl ester resins are bonded to form the complete hull.

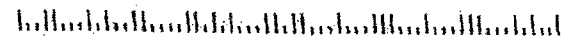

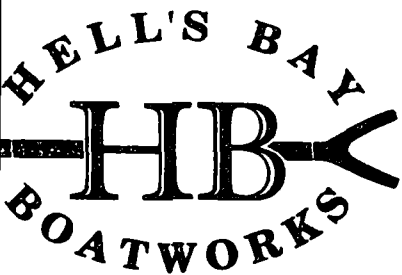

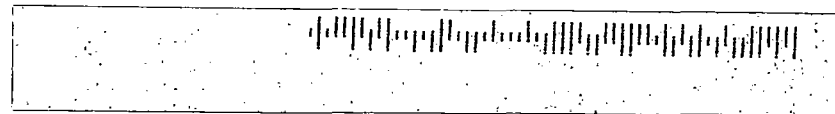
