This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.3 lo to operate your facility was received on October 30, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. <u>0110020-005</u> to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty (30) days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after five (5) years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than five (5) years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

Description of Facility

A ready mix concrete facility, comprised of two concrete batching plants, producing a combined total of 350 cubic yards/hr [±656 tons/hour] — 16 hours/day; 6 day/week; 52 weeks/year — emissions from cement/flyash/PenCem storage silos, weigh hoppers, & RMC truck loadouts controlled by a combination of silo mounted baghouses and central dust collectors.

Concrete Batch Plant #1

EU 01- C & W Model CP-305

Top of silo mounted baghouse controlling the easternmost single stand alone cement storage silo. The collector has 8 - 8" x 39" cartridges with 365 sq.ft. of filtration area and CFM of 1,600 for an air to cloth ratio of 4.5 (ACFM/ sq.ft.). The baghouse has a pulse jet with timer as a cartridge cleaning mechanism.

ÉU 02, 03 and 04- C & W Model LPR-6-S

Three (3) top of silo mounted baghouses controlling two storage silos (one on each compartment of a split silo and one on a standard silo). Each collector has 8 - 8" x 39" cartridges with 365 sq.ft. of filtration area and CFM of 2,340 for an air to cloth ratio of 6.4 (ACFM/sq.ft.). The baghouses have a pulse jet with timer for a cartridge cleaning mechanism.

EU 05- C & W Model KR-1100

Central dust collector controlling weigh hopper and mixer truck loadout spout. The collector has 70 - 6" x 120" bags with 1100 sq.ft. of filtration area for an air to cloth ratio of 6. The bags are cleaned via pulse jet with timer.

Concrete Batch Plant # 2

EU 06 and 07- C & W Model LPR-6-S

Two (2) top of silo mounted baghouses controlling two storage silos. Each collector has 8 - 8" x 39" cartridges with 365 sq.ft. of filtration area and CFM of 2,340 for an air to cloth ratio of 6.4 (ACFM/sq.ft.). The baghouses have a pulse jet with timer for a cartridge cleaning mechanism.

EU 08- C & W Model CP-900

Dust collector controlling weigh hopper and mixer truck loadout spout. the collector has 12 - 8" x 78" cartridges with 1069 sq.ft. of filtration area and CFM of 5,000 for an air to cloth ratio of 4.7 (ACFM/sq.ft.). The baghouse has a pulse jet with timer for a cartridge cleaning mechanism.
