Dear Mr. Kashuv,

We have received your Surface Coating Operations Air General Permit Registration renewal and fee (March 7, 2012). In order for me to successfully complete the review and processing of your renewal, I will need additional updated/corrected information. You may submit this information to me via e-mail and I will simply attach your e-mail response as an addendum to your submitted form.

Please see page four (4), **Re-registration section**, of the attached .pdf file, which is a copy of your submitted registration.

1. You have reported/indicated your answers in what appears to be **gallons** of product used rather than **VOC's** in **lbs./day** averaged monthly. **In the Re-registration section on Page four (4) you are required by rule to provide the following:**

→ Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) – ***“...the highest monthly average of the daily quantity of volatile organic compounds in all coatings (solvents and thinners) used in the last five years.”***

(Your answer should be expressed in **VOC lbs/day**, averaged monthly, using thirty (30) days to average. The **VOC** threshold limit for the Surface Coating Operations Air General Permit Registration is **44 lbs/day**.)

2. You did not indicate the Month & Year of the highest VOC use. **In the Re-registration section on Page four (4) you are required by rule to provide the following:**

→ Highest Use – ***“Indicate the month and year during which this usage occurred.”***

Thank you for your immediate attention to this matter. There are only eight (8) days remaining in the mandatory thirty (30) day review and processing period so it is important that you respond as soon as possible as I do not want to have to deny your permit registration. Please help me bring this to a successful conclusion.
