Dear Mr. Capps:


This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on February 12, 2007. We have assigned ARMS Number 0390042-001 to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.

### Description of Facility

Quincy Printing & Graphics is a very small local printer serving the Gadsden County area. It is a two-person shop, the owner and one employee. Operating hours are 8:00am – 4:30pm most days, 5 days per week. The primary products printed are business cards, letterhead, envelopes, all types of NCR forms, labels, tickets, newsletters and church programs. Sales for the last calendar year were \$180,000.

Quincy Printing uses a non-heatset lithographic process. We have three presses:

- Multi Lith 1250 Duplicator (11 x 17) – 2 presses
- AB Dick 360 (11 x 17) – 1 press

Film is developed by hand, with developer and fixer. Plates are developed by hand – metal plates are used.

Chemicals used in the Multi Lith and AB Dick presses are fountain solution, blanket and roller wash, and inks (rubber-based and petroleum-based).

Part purchase invoices for chemicals will be used to determine the quantity used for reporting purposes under the Material Usage Approach.

I do not plan any material, process or equipment changes in the future.

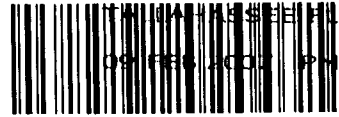
