The facility only has 2 gasoline tanks. Both tanks have submerged fills. The tanks don't have a vapor recovery system. The tanks have 2" updraft vents. Gasoline is stored in tanks T-2 and T-4. Both tanks hold 20,000 gallons each. The facility uses top loading arms to fill the trucks. The arms are lowered to bottom of the compartment and filled from the bottom up to minimize emissions. The rack does not have a vapor recovery system.
