The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on July 2, 2001.



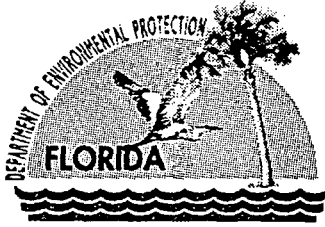

Dear Ms. Tadros:

Thank you for your October 29 letter requesting a transfer of ownership form for a Title V Air General Permit facility. Your request was received by the Hazardous Waste Cleanup Section and forwarded to the Division of Air Resource Management for a response.

Rule 62-213.300(3), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), states the air "general permit is not transferable and does not follow a change in ownership of the facility." Prior to any sale, other change of ownership, or permanent shutdown of the facility, the responsible official shall notify the Department."

Upon receipt of your October 29 letter stating that the facility was sold, the sale of The Dry Cleaner (AIRS ID #0571035) was noted in the database.

Dry cleaning facilities seeking entitlement to use an air general permit under the Title V program must submit a notification form. As a new owner, Mr. Rajnicant J. Patel must complete and submit a Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaner Air General Permit Notification Form. A notification form may be obtained by calling the Small Business Assistance Program at 800/722-7457.

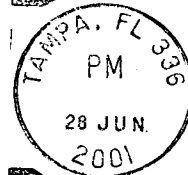
