The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the secondary aluminum sweat furnace facility that you submitted on June 18, 2003.



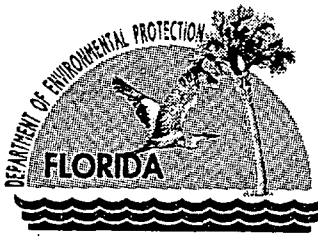

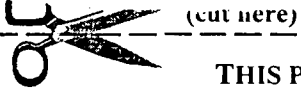
