The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on June 20, 2001.



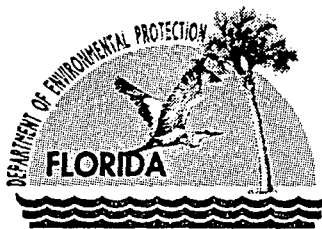

Thank you for your submittal of the Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaners Air General Permit Notification Form. The Department received your submittal on June 20.

In reviewing your submittal, it was noted that Pugh's Dry Cleaners, Inc. elected to surrender its existing Title V air general permit (AIRS ID 0694808).
