The Department has received the Title V General Permit Notification Form for the dry cleaning facility that you submitted on January 24, 2006.



The Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaning Facility Notification of Intent to Use General Permit, Part III of this form, shall be completed and submitted to the Division of Air Resources Management at least 30 days prior to beginning operations under the general permit. 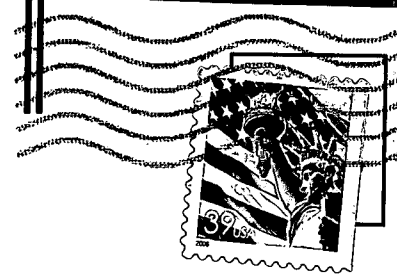

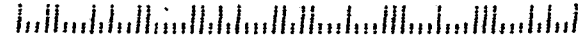

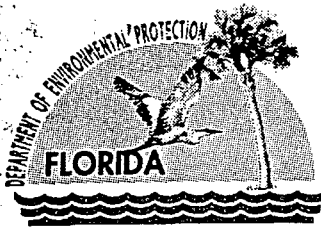

Please contact me if you have any questions or if I can be of further assistance.

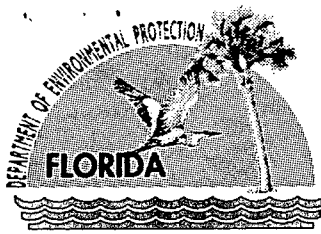
