This is to acknowledge that your notification of intent to use the authority of Rule 62-210.310 to operate your facility was received on July 22, 2008. We have assigned ARMS No. <u>0710269-001</u> to this facility.

As you know, pursuant to Florida Statutes section 403.814, authority to operate under general permits commences thirty days after receipt of the registration form unless you have been notified by this office that your facility has not shown entitlement to operate pursuant to the rule provisions.

For your information, authority to operate pursuant to Rule 62-210.310 expires after 5 years. Therefore, a new registration form must be received no later than 5 years after the date your notice was received as indicated above. If your general permit rule conditions require testing, such testing must be completed within the time frame specified in the rule.



Thank you for your response and it seems that you are correct. I have been unable to locate any permittee by the name of Automated Fuel Technologies LLC d.b.a. Fuelman and therefore most likely not previously entitled

The young lady that I talked with this morning at the Hanson Street Facility indicated that there were two purchases made by Quick Fuel Fleet Services LLC, but couldn't provide a lot of detail.

She indicated that the two facilities were at neighboring locations and that now everything was centralized at 2650 Hanson Street in Ft Myers. She provided the following named businesses as follows, but could not provide a lot of details:

- 1) Dockside located at 3450 Canal Street, Ft Myers; and
- 2) **West Coast** located on **Piccadilly** she apparently verified this from a former West Coast driver currently employed w/ Quick Fuel Fleet Services.

Would you be so kind as to verify or discount any of the above information for me. I want to be certain that when I create this new facility I am not duplicating one that may already exist.
