The system also assists delivery by commercial firms, and is increasingly being used for real estate transactions.

THIS IS YOUR NEW MAILING ADDRESS IF YOU RECEIVE YOUR MAIL AT YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS. IF YOU RECEIVE YOUR MAIL IN A POST OFFICE BOX THERE WILL BE NO CHANGE IN THAT MAILING ADDRESS.

Please begin using this new address immediately. It is your responsibility to inform your correspondents of this change using form 3576 cards available at any Post Office. The above address is permanent for this location and will not change as postal routes may change.

Old and new addresses will be recognized and delivered for 12 months. After this time the old address will be removed from the United States Postal Service database. We urge you to consider putting your new number on the building as soon as possible to help your local fire, rescue and police departments find you in an emergency.

The 911 program is a very worthwhile project, designed to improve the health and welfare of our citizens, and every effort has been made to make sure the address above is for your house or business.
